- is a scholarship Catholic middle school for young men in the Diocese of Rockville Centre
- provides an innovative educational opportunity for youngsters from economically disadvantaged backgrounds (more than 75 percent of students qualify for free or reduced price federal lunch)
- was established in 2002 – beginning with eleven fifth grade students
- currently enrolls more than five dozen students in grades five through eight
- is rooted in more than 325 years of De La Salle Christian Brothers tradition
- maintains a curriculum which meets and surpasses the guidelines established by the Board of Regents of the State of New York
- provides a “Breakfast Club” serving milk and cereal for all students every morning
- welcomes students from Freeport, Roosevelt, Uniondale, Hempstead, Elmont, Rosedale, Baldwin, Amityville, and Westbury
- maintains contact with 49 alumni from four graduating classes who are currently enrolled in a five private and ten public high schools
- schedules field trips to New York Hall of Science, Long Island Children’s Museum, Bishop Loughlin Memorial High School, Adams Playhouse at Hofstra University, Alley Pond Park, Firefighters’ Museum in Garden City, Fire Island Lighthouse and more
- offers “Extended Day” supervised study time and social activities Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 3:30 to 5 PM
- participates in co-curricular activities such as week long visits to Spring Brook Farm in Vermont for the *Farms for City Kids* program
- encourages parental involvement
- receives financial support from 100 percent of its Board of Trustees
